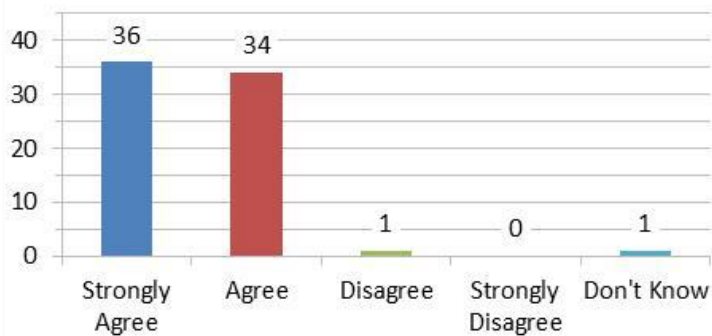


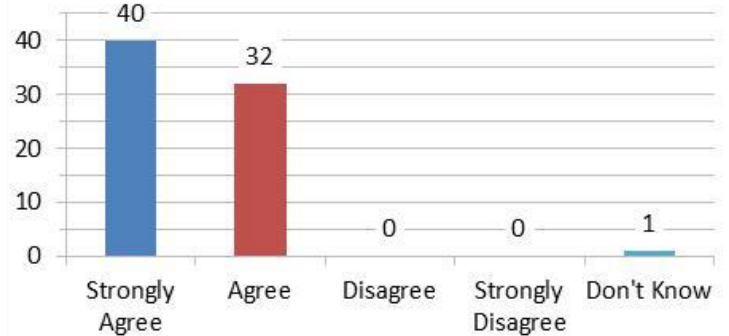

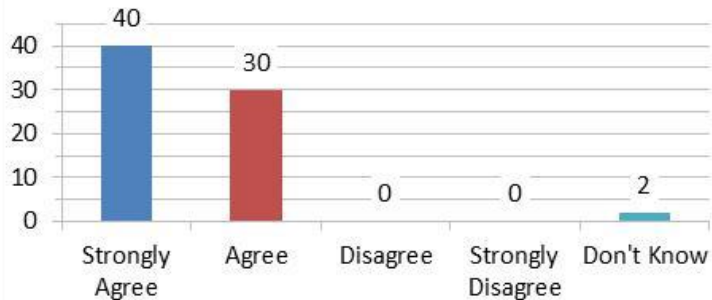
1. My child is happy at this school



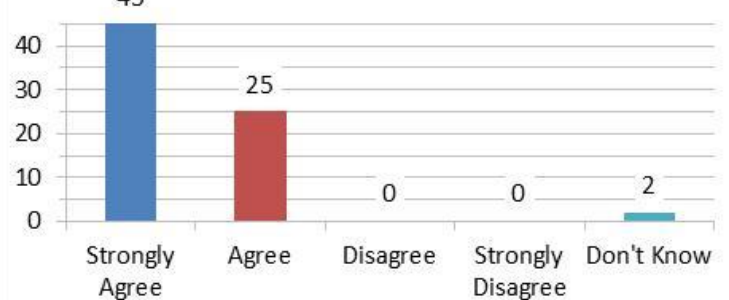
2. My child feels safe at this school



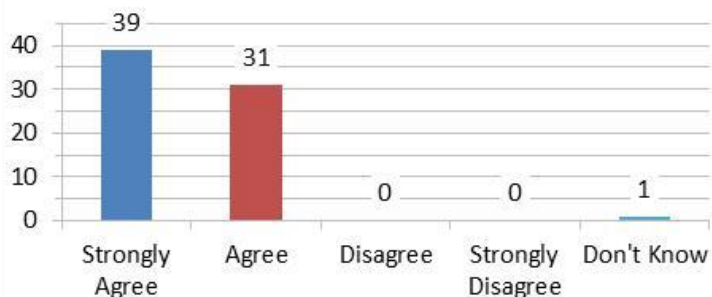

Response from school: We will look into this, as the email function on the website should ensure you get a reply from school.
- I feel that any concerns re missed homework or inappropriate behaviour/lack of focus should be communicated early to parents.
- I find your setting of pupils according to their CAT test and then changing it in Year 9 extremely dumb.
Response from school: We set in year 7 based on pupils' SAT scores from primary school, but this is only our starting point. For further details, please watch the very short video on our website under Parents/Key Stage 3 called "Key Stage 3: Setting Structure".
- I appreciate all the support and extra effort the teachers give of themselves. I am happy with my daughter's progress.
- If, on Parents' Evenings, a parent has a fundamental concern/issue, then they should make an appointment to return, NOT spend 20-30 minutes airing all their issues. It is disrespectful to the teacher and other parents.
Response from school: If parents wish to have a more detailed discussion, they should speak with their child's House Achievement Leader. Teachers' appointments should only last 5 minutes so that all parents can be seen.
- Excellent school, would recommend, however I did have an issue with my other daughter and I felt that it wasn't dealt with effectively or as best it would have been.
- Can the gate from the park into school be opened in a morning and at the end of school?
Response from school: The path through Astley Park is not a Local Authority designated route to school, and for safeguarding purposes, we have been advised to keep the gate closed.
